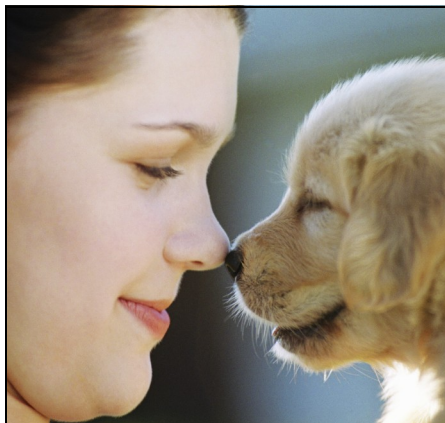

WINTER 2010 DOG-TRAINING CLASS SCHEDULE

REGISTRATION

Class enrollment: All classes begin on Monday, Oct. 26, 2009. Classes have limited enrollment; register early to ensure placement. If you register late and the class is full, you will be notified; however confirmation of successful applications will not be sent.

Requirement: All dogs must have current vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination is required on the night of the first class (except in Super Puppy). Please, no flexi-leads.

Classes: All classes are held on Monday nights and are approximately 45 minutes long. *No classes held on second Monday of every month due to Kennel Club meeting. All persons and dogs are welcome.*

Class location: Classes are held at the Masonic Lodge, 6161 Slater St., Merriam, Kan. The classroom is in the lower level of the building (door is on the east side of building).

CLASS SCHEDULE

How to Raise a Super Puppy

6 p.m. - Instructor: Peggy Reisinger

Cost: \$50 SKC members; \$60 nonmembers

Using positive reinforcement and your puppy's natural desire to please you, this class will provide basic training techniques to help you create the behaviors of a Super Puppy. Things to bring: your puppy, tasty treats (i.e., hotdog bits), a rug or blanket for the floor, your puppy's favorite toy; a flat-buckle collar, a 4- to 6-foot leash. Puppies must be up-to-date on all shots up to 8 weeks of age. No puppies under 8 weeks are allowed. This is a six-week class.

Beginner Obedience

7 p.m. - Instructor: Janet Croy/Mary Warner

Cost: \$50 SKC members; \$60 nonmembers

Beginner obedience skills are taught: sit, stay, down, come and heel. Class is limited to 12 dogs. Canine Good Citizen certification test is given on the last night of the class.

Novice Obedience/Rally

8 p.m. - Instructor: Peggy Reisinger

Cost: \$50 SKC members; \$60 nonmembers

This class will help you and your dog prepare for competition in the Novice Obedience ring. Limited to 10 dogs. All dogs must be current on vaccinations; proof of rabies vaccination is required on the first night.

Junior Handling Novice Handling Conformation

6 p.m. - Instructor: Carol Huskey

(or alternate instructors)

All dogs must be current on their vaccinations to attend class. Proof of rabies vaccinations is required on the first night of the class (except for Super Puppy).

Cost: \$50 SKC members; \$60 nonmembers

Junior Handling: Class is for handlers younger than 18 years old who want to compete in the Junior Showmanship at dog shows. Learn proper stacking, gaiting and presentation.

Novice Handling: This class is for the beginner conformation exhibitor. This class will focus more one-on-one with the exhibitor and teach techniques of stacking, free-stacking, gaiting and all other aspects of handling for the beginner. Limited to 12 dogs.

Conformation: Learn proper AKC techniques for stacking and gaiting presentation.

Cost: \$50 SKC members; \$60 nonmembers

Walk-in: \$6 SKC members; \$8 nonmembers

Conformation for dogs examined on the floor. Class size limited to 12 dogs. All dogs must be current on vaccinations; proof of rabies vaccination is required on the first night.

AKC CGC Testing

Offered every class session. Canine Good Citizen Certificate awarded to those dogs and owners who complete and pass the required AKC test for this title. Successful completion of Beginner Obedience enables you and your dog for this as well as getting a good start towards becoming a Therapy Dog or being involved in a local Read To The Dogs (children) program. Training areas covered: Accept friendly strangers, sit politely, acceptable grooming appearance, walking on a loose lead, sit/down/stay on command in place, come when called, acceptable reaction to other dogs and distractions, 3 minute supervised separation from owner. This is a great way to give back to the community and share your dog's love with other!
